Auction Rules

Welcome to our virtual auction! This year's auction works a little differently than in the past. You'll find everything you need to know for registering and bidding here.

Registration

To participate in both the Silent and Live Auctions, you'll need to register at this link: udistrictfoodbank.ejoinme.org/tickets. You can pre-register a credit card on the registration page that will be used to charge your purchases at the auction.

After you register, you'll receive an email with a link to the bidding site: udfb2020.ggo.bid. Go to the link and click the button in the upper right that says **START BIDDING**.

On the next page, click the green **CREATE ACCOUNT** button and follow the instructions. Look for a verification email in your inbox. Click the verification link in the email and double check that the information you entered is correct.

Silent Auction

The Silent Auction opens Monday, Oct. 19 at 8 a.m., and closes Monday, Oct. 26 at noon.

To bid on Silent Auction items, go to the link you received in the email confirming your registration. It will say: “Start Online Bidding as *** ” with your name where the *** is.

On the night of the auction, go to the “Start Online Bidding” link in your email. Scroll down to see the auction items.

Search for packages by name or number by using the magnifying glass or by choosing a category under the menu.

You can Bid the next increment or Bid More than the next increment. If you choose Bid More you can set your max bid. If your max bid is the highest, the system will automatically bid in your favor until you are outbid or until the auction closes.

To “watch” a package, select the star icon on the package.

You’ll be notified if you’re outbid at any point before the auction closes and you will see an Outbid notice at the top of your screen.

To get back to the main screen, click the house icon.

Live Auction

To watch the Live Auction, go to this link: youtube.com/watch?v=YjVAyZ8iSrs. You’ll need a computer or Smart TV to watch. You’ll use your smartphone or tablet to place bids or donate.

Streaming of the Live Auction program begins at 7 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 24. The Live Auction closes at 9 p.m. on October 24.

Dessert Dash

The Dessert Dash opens Monday, Oct. 19, and closes Friday, Oct. 23. Desserts will be delivered to the winners the morning of Saturday, October 24.

Paying For And Picking Up Your Winning Items

All sales are final. Winning bids will be charged to the credit card you registered at sign-in.

The signer/designated bidder must make payment for items that are jointly purchased by two or more parties. The designated bidder shall be responsible for making arrangements for reimbursement from the co-purchasers.

Gift cards will be mailed.

Wine can be either picked up at the Food Bank or mailed.

We prefer you pick up physical items you have purchased at the Food Bank, but we can make other arrangements if that doesn’t work out.
